<p>English</p> <p>Non-Fiction, Information texts, and explanation texts: Pupils will draw on different features of text including print, sound and image to obtain meaning. Pupils will write instructions using a range of organisational devices.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Statistics: Pupils will learn to sort and interpret information from a Venn diagram, they will learn to construct a pictogram, where the scale is greater than 1. Pupils will represent and interpret data in charts and diagrams, they will collect and represent data, using ICT.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Living things and their habitats, variation: Pupils will experience the wide variety of living things in the world, they will explore similarities and differences between humans, other animals, and plants. They will also work on grouping living things by classifying them in simple ways.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>How does our community care for others? Pupils will focus on how they can show care and help others in their community, they will explore what organisations are in their local area that help others and what the religious communities are doing locally to help people.</p>	<p>Art/DT</p> <p>Alarms: Pupils will learn why we need alarms and what alarms are used for, they will focus on how to design, make, and use switches to operate an alarm system. They will also learn to connect, test, and evaluate alarm circuits.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>The Class Orchestra: Pupils will learn different sections of an orchestra; they will learn the role of individual instruments within an orchestral setting. Pupils will learn the elements required to create an orchestral piece of music.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>Crime and punishment: Pupils will learn the terms used in crime and punishment, they learn about what the Romans believed about crime and punishment. They will learn how the legal system worked in Anglo-Saxon Britain. Pupils will learn about Tudor punishment methods.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> <p>One world: Pupils will be able to name the seven continents of the world and locate the UK on a world map. Pupils will learn the importance of biodiversity and the impact humans can have, they will learn the importance of sustainability within the world and global citizenship.</p>	<p>Relationship Education</p> <p>People who help me: Pupils will learn about the following: Who can I talk to if I feel anxious or unhappy? Where can I find information about growing up? Pupils will learn how to ask for advice or help.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Online safety: Pupils will learn that a range of information can be accessed on the internet, but that not all information is true. They will learn that the internet can be used for communication, and how it should be used safely.</p>
