<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Fiction: Pupils will learn how to identify the plot of a story - starting event, conflicts and complications, climax of the story, the resolution. They will learn how to use their understanding to write their own story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Four operations: Pupils will learn how addition and subtraction can be performed with various methods, they will learn how to estimate and check answers. Pupils will learn how to use repeated addition to multiply numbers and they will focus on solving word problems.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Using Electricity: Pupils will learn the practical applications of electricity, and the main sources of power. They will learn how to be safe when using electricity, And how to create a variety of simple circuits.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>What do the creation stories teach us? Pupils will learn the meaning of creator and creation. They will learn how creation stories influence people's belief and behaviour and will focus on sharing their own opinions and beliefs on creation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art/DT</p> <p>Can Buildings Speak? Pupils will learn how to explore shape and pattern in buildings, they will learn how to produce prints and rubbings of patterns found in buildings. Pupils will learn how to record the use of shape, space and pattern in local buildings.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Victorian music: Pupils will learn types of music popular in Victorian times, they will learn the structure of brass bands. Pupils will learn about Victorian composers, and the structure of parlour music. Pupils will learn how to create a class performance.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Stone Age to the Iron Age: Know what humans needed for survival in the Stone Age Know what was found at Skara Brae and why it is important Know what copper mining meant to the people of the Bronze Age Know how evidence can give different answers</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>Recycling and Rules: Pupils will learn what constitutes as rubbish, they will learn how to take some responsibility for the sustainability of the environment by gathering recyclable materials. Why is my body changing?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Finding Information: Pupils will learn how to use a website effectively in order to research information.
