Curriculum Map - Term 2 Upper Key Stage 2



English

Non-Fiction – Diaries, autobiographies, and letters: Pupils will explore the features of personal profiles, they will create a factual account. They will learn when and how to use the techniques of persuasion, and understand hr difference between fact and opinion.

Maths

Four operations: pupils will understand how addition and subtraction can be performed with various methods. They will identify factors and multiples of a given number, and will multiply and divide whole numbers by powers of ten. Pupils will understand division strategies, and consider how the order of operations will affect the answer.

Science

Properties and changes of materials: Pupils will learn about solids, liquids and gases. They will look at how changes can be reversible and irreversible, and they will explore the changes that occur when solids and liquids are mixed. Following on they will then work on separating solids.

RE

Does having a religion help people to be peaceful? Pupils will recognise conflict and peace in their daily lives, and consider the difference between war and peace. They will learn what different religions say about war and peace.

Art/DT

the identify properties different materials and their functional value. They will carry out a design and make activity for a specific purpose.

Music

Finding an Identity: Pupils will Musical vocabulary and orchestras: Pupils will explore the various sections of an orchestra, they will create a musical piece, using a graphic score. Pupils will understand basic rhythmic patterns and will explore different instrumental techniques to create an ostinato pattern.

History

World War II: Pupils will learn how World War II began and order events from early World War II on a timeline. They will learn about evacuees, and how people's diets were different during World War II. Pupils will learn about women's wartime jobs, they will learn about the Holocaust.

Being aware of my ability: Pupils will My Body: Pupils will learn about recognise their personal qualities and what makes them special. They will focus on their own abilities and how they learn, they will set their own goals and make their own success criteria.

Relationship Education
