As we approach the end of the Autumn term, we want to thank you for your cooperation in supporting our pupils' attendance.

GANF would like to celebrate the fact that our school's attendance rate is above the national average for special schools. The national absence rate for special schools is 11.9%, while our current absence rate is 8%. This is particularly significant as we are well into cold and flu season, and we understand that motivation can be challenging with the darker mornings and dreary weather.
