<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Reading contemporary fiction: Pupils learn how to analyse an image and predict the outcome of a novel based on the image and blurb, they will focus on using key vocabulary from a text to create an image. Pupils will learn how to analyse how language effects our impressions of a character, they will learn how to write from the perspective of a character taking into consideration their attitude. Pupils will learn how to analyse the use of writing for tension and how it effects the audience, they will learn how to consider alternative meanings of a piece of text.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Ratio, Proportion and Rates of Change: Pupils will learn to identify, compare and order fractions, they will also learn to calculate fractions of a quantity. Pupils will learn how fractions can be represented as percentages; they will learn to use appropriate vocabulary linked to ratio and proportion. Pupils will learn to calculate the amount of a number using fractions and percentages, they will also learn about ratio notation and how to express quantities into a ratio. Pupils will learn to enlarge shapes by a scale factor, they will learn how to use scale factors to read maps and a scale diagram. Pupils will learn to calculate rates of change, they will learn to read graphs to convert between two measures.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Energy: Pupils will learn to identify different energy stores that objects have and explain why they have each store of energy. They will learn to identify when stores of energy change and describe causes of energy transfer between stores. Pupils will learn how energy is measured and learn how to calculate power; they will learn about the use of fossil fuels in the generation of electricity. Pupils will learn how to evaluate alternative energy resources, and they will compare the energy values of different foods.</p>
