## Lower Key Stage 2

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>Poetry - Modern and classic poetry, poetic style: Pupils will learn about the structure of poems and the features used within. They will explore the use of rhythm and rhyme, and how imagery is used to make poems effective. They will study a variety of poems.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Geometry: Pupils will draw 2d shapes with knowledge of properties, they will identify horizontal and vertical lines on a shape. Pupils will recognise angles as a description of a turn, and recognise 3D shapes in different orientations constructing a 3D shape from a kit.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>Characteristics of Materials: Pupils will explore properties of materials and encounter materials practically. They will find out about the uses of some materials, and look at the characteristics of materials and how these are useful.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>Why is sharing food important on special occasions? Pupils will learn how food is important, why and how people share food. They will explore stories from different religions about sharing food and focus on what food is special in religious celebrations.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art/DT</b></p> <p>Musical Instruments: Pupils will learn how musical instruments are made. They will work together to design and make a music instrument which can be used to accompany a performance. They will use a variety of tools and materials.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music</b></p> <p>Tudor music: Pupils will understand what musical instruments were used in Tudor times, focusing on musical notation of crotchet, minim and semibreve. Pupils will indicate how many beats to play, they will explore and compare Tudor music.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Land use: Pupils will learn to use simple sketch maps that show how land is used, they will draw a simple sketch map. Pupils will use a key on a map to show how land is used, they will describe land use in urban and rural areas in the UK. Pupils will learn how land is used for farming.</p>

Pupils will learn to add and format an image, they will learn how to edit and finalise their PowerPoint.
