



# Curriculum Map - Term 3

## Upper Key Stage 2

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>Poetry - Reading poetry - Modern and classic poetry: Pupils will know the different parts that make up a poem, and explore how imagery can help make a poem effective. They will explore features used within poems, and study twentieth century and pre-twentieth poetry.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Geometry: Pupils will identify, sort and draw polygons, triangles and quadrilaterals. They will identify parallel and perpendicular lines on a shape. Pupils will use a protractor to measure and draw angles, and will calculate the missing value of an angle. They will understand the formation of a net and read and plot co-ordinates.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>Living things and their habitats: Pupils will learn about habitat and environment variations, they will explore animal adaptations to environmental changes in their habitats, food chains and animal adaptations as predators and prey.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>How and why do organisations like the Salvation Army help others? Pupils will explore what makes them unhappy about the world, they will think about William Booth and why he began the Salvation Army and consider how they can help a charity.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art/DT</b></p> <p>People in action: Pupils will learn how to convey movement in their work, and learn how to use dynamic activities such as sport, dance, drama and music as a starting point for making work in two dimensions. Pupils will learn how to use different techniques.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music</b></p> <p>Film music: Pupils will learn how composers create happy and sad moods through their music and elements. They will link music to particular genres of film and learn the impact music has on emotions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Exploring Eastern Europe: Pupils will identify the countries of Europe and the capital city of a country. They will compare features and climate of eastern European landscapes. Pupils will compare the human geography of eastern European regions with their own.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Medicines and Medication, Personal Hygiene and Exercise is fun: Pupils will understand and learn the purposes of a range of medicines, the importance of personal hygiene and why it is important to be healthy and exercise.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Relationship Sex Education</b></p> <p>Feelings, attitudes and mental wellbeing: Pupils will learn how puberty can impact on emotions. Pupils will learn about feelings of attraction and the concept of a boyfriend and girlfriend.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Developing Presentation skills: Pupils will focus on creating a story, they will learn how to add themes, transitions and animations along with how to use hyperlinks within their story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MFL</b></p> <p>In German pupils will learn numbers 71 - 80, they will focus on key school phrases and learn school subjects.</p>
